Rules: how things get done	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Outline official and written down rules</li> <li>• Unofficial (rules) and expressed through norms, values, laws, traditions, and customs</li> </ul>
Activities: what is done	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• who does what?</li> <li>• who gets what?</li> <li>• who can claim what?</li> </ul>
Resources: what is used, what is produced	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Outline Human resources.</li> <li>• Material resource and,</li> <li>• Intangible resources (social networks)</li> </ul>
People: who is in, who is out, who does what	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• who is allow in and who is excluded; Why?</li> <li>• who is assigned various resources, tasks, and responsibilities;</li> <li>• who is positioned where in the hierarchy</li> </ul>
Power: who decides, and whose interests are served	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• who decides, (resource allocation, roles, sanctions and rewards) and why</li> <li>• whose interests are served</li> </ul>
